RWA is publishing hybrid editions: in addition to the printed music volume, there is a substantial digital apparatus in which the available source materials (manuscripts, first prints, letters and further explanatory documents) are made available and scientifically processed.

You have a degree in musicology (at least Magister/Magistra or Master) or a comparable scientific qualification as well as experience in the field of scholarly music editing. A research focus on 19th/20th century music history as well as experience in working with common music notation applications is desirable. Furthermore, you are open to familiarise yourself with digital edition tools (Edirom, Oxygen) and data standards (XML, TEI/MEI) in a highly digital and German speaking workplace setting.

You are able to cope with time critical project milestones and to work independently as well as a member of our project team.
